Home & Heart - a Lunch & Auction Gala

Dear Basil & Chives patrons,

As you already knew, a devastating earthquake struck Haiti in January, killing over 200,000 and leaving millions homeless, including children who became orphans due to this disaster. Since then, makeshift camps with tarps for roofs and dirt for floor serve as “home” to these millions. March is the beginning of rain season in Haiti – these camps will be flooded. Dysentery, giardia, typhoid, hepatitis and how many other fatal diseases will strike these survivors? My name is Quyen, wife and mother of 2, a healthcare provider, and owner of Basil & Chives. Each time I watch Haiti news, I keep seeing my children in the faces of Haitian orphans wandering the streets looking for “home”. If this happened to us, will someone reach out a hand to help my children? Will someone help yours?

In an effort to raise fund for Haiti earthquake victims, Basil & Chives Restaurant is collaborating with Seattle King County Disaster Team (SKCDT at www.waldmat.com). SKCDT is a nonprofit organization comprised of volunteer medical professionals who travel to disaster-stricken locations to help. I know some of these volunteers personally. We are planning “Home & Heart, a lunch & auction gala for Haiti earthquake victims” on March 14th, at 1 PM at Basil & Chives. Home & Heart will feature a buffet lunch, live entertainment and live auction. Basil & Chives will donate food, drinks, services, auction items and venue. Since SKCDT volunteers pay for all their trips’ expenses out of pocket, 100% of all ticket & auction sales will go directly to the people of Haiti via SKCDT to provide for food & medical necessities.

Ticket prices are: regular \$45, VIP \$100 (includes wine or beer), sponsorship \$500 or more (includes a table for your business advertisement, mentioning & 1 VIP pass). A detailed description of “Comedy x3”

“Comedy x3” is a collection of one act plays assembled by Last Leaf for an evening of human observations and laughter about people and how they relate and communicate with each other. Currently scheduled for the evening are “Watch and Dry” by Shel Silverstein – famous for his collections of poems for children this is one of many works for adult audiences, “Textual Healing” by Mavis Lamb- a Seattle playwright, and “Graceland” by Ellen Byron to celebrate this 75th anniversary of the birth of Elvis Presley.

“Watch and Dry” is a short play about assumptions and how people never really pay attention to the world around them. “Textual Healing” was recently presented at a festival of new plays at Arts West in West Seattle and takes a humorous look at how dependence on new technology can totally mess up a budding relationship. “Graceland” is a sometimes funny, often touching play about two very different women with one common goal. They both want to be the first visitor into Elvis Presley’s mansion, Graceland, when it is opened to the public. As they camp out in front of the gates waiting for them to open, each talks about her troubles, triumphs and her love for “the King”.
